Covid Safe Practice

From next weekend July 03-04 the following will take effect:

- we return to 3 weekend Masses – Sat 5.30pm, Sun 9.00am & 5.30pm
- 6 months roster for Readers, Commentators and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC)

Due to new cases of COVID in NSW and the expected movement of people for school holidays we will delay the following changes until the first weekend of August (31/07-1/08):

- spacing of church pews to return to normal.
- ministers will no longer be required to wear face masks during the distribution of holy communion,

Our History, Our Story | 1971-1981

Notice was received of a vacancy in South Tamworth Parish following Father Meehan's retirement. Mgr. Frank Ryan suggested Father Le Fevre apply for the Parish. He had enjoyed his stay there as Administrator in 1969.

He had a strong devotion to Mary, Help of Christians, and here could be an unexpected opportunity to build a church in her honour, so he applied for South Tamworth. It was the Bishop, offering him the position of Parish Priest at South.

Father Le Fevre has a claim to fame few can match. He was born in a Police Station! His father was Sergeant of Police at Islington, a Newcastle suburb and the family lived at the Police Station. A few years later the family moved to Tamworth. Frank was educated at the Christian Brothers in Carthage Street. Finishing school after the Leaving Certificate, he worked for several years in the Commonwealth Bank at Tamworth and Inverell. He played Rugby League for Tamworth City first grade. Also he loved dancing and was a regular at the Saturday night "Hops". Then to everyone's surprise, he entered the Seminary at Springwood, followed by Manly. He was ordained in 1961 at Meadowbank, where the family was then living. In 1962 appointment in the Armidale Diocese. He served in several parishes and enjoyed them all.
