The 10 COVID Safe Practices

1. Any person with co-morbidities and those over 70 years of age should exercise particular caution.
2. In some cases it may be more appropriate for some individuals to attend a weekday Mass when there are less people present or to receive pastoral care from clergy in their home.
3. DO NOT ENTER if you are unwell, have fever or respiratory infection or have been to any COVID-19 hotspot area in the last 14 days.
4. Always check-in (QR code or manually) before entering the church.
5. Please observe physical distancing inside the Church, in the foyer and immediate surroundings.
6. Use hand sanitiser when entering and leaving the church. Always practice good hygiene.
7. Church bulletins are for single use only. Please take them with you when you leave.
8. The use of cry room is reserved only for parents with pre-school children. Maximum of 3 families.
9. After each Service, the pews, door handles and touchpoints are cleaned with disinfectants.
10. All are required to wear a facemask inside the church.

Lockdown Lifted & Restrictions

The announcement on Thursday (09/09) that lockdown has been lifted in parts of regional NSW applies to all local government areas which have seen zero COVID19 cases for at least 14 days. This applies to all LGA's in our Diocese except Narrabri and Walgett where stay at home orders remain in place.

The key points are:

- i. The lockdown is lifted at 12.01am Saturday 11th September, 2021
- ii. The ongoing restrictions which will apply are:
 - a. Up to 5 visitors will be allowed in a home
 - b. Up to 20 people can gather in an outdoor setting
 - c. Schools will reopen with Level 3 COVID Safe measures in place
 - d. Up to 50 guests can attend weddings
 - e. Up to 50 mourners can attend funerals
 - f. Churches can open subject to the one person per 4 square metre rule with no singing.
 - g. Masks remain mandatory for all indoor public venues including churches and you must still have the QR code sign-in facility.

Our History, Our Story | 1981-1991

Father Frank told parishioners the church would be dedicated to Mary, Help of Christians, appointed Australia's patroness at the first Synod in Sydney in 1844. (The Robert Street Church was called St Mary's.) The parish and schools would remain St Edward's. St Edward would be the saint prayed to at Mass.

Now fund raising was back to the fore. A Colonial lunch was held at 'Calala,' Denison Street in June, with local historian Lyall Green, telling us of the early days of the Church in Tamworth. A 'Hoedown' was held at Rosary College assembly hall. 'Strenuous' was the only word to describe the evening but these functions raised \$1,300 between them. Football Pools and the Art Union were resurrected. Everyone was enthusiastic about helping, especially now things were really moving.
