#### Our History, Our Story | 1981-1991

In August seven sets of plans were distributed to tenderers. A model of the building went on display. Site preparation work was taken out of the contract to save time. Pat Grace, who had worked so hard on the School oval almost ten years before, was back on the job with his bulldozer on 22<sup>nd</sup> August to turn the first sod for the new church on the Hillvue site. Three test holes sunk on the site revealed solid shale. Our new church would not sink.

The Groennau Constructions, recent builders of the Primary School extensions won the tender with the prices of \$389,613 for building only. Expected cost of carpets and furnishings, park ing, landscaping, professional fees were expected to be another \$120,000. After a long wait our Church/School Assembly Complex envisaged so many years ago by Father Meehan, but postponed so many times by the need for classrooms, was coming into fruition for the same reason the need for more infant classroom space.
