Our History, Our Story | 1961-2021

Many people have an ambition in life they hope to achieve. Father Frank's by any standards, was unusual - to build a church in honour of Mary, Help of Christians. Yet the circumstances of his priestly life gave him this very opportunity, a generous gift from God.

For the 25th Anniversary of his Ordination in 1986, parishioners had presented him with a painting of his Church by Werris Creek artist, Philip Pomeroy, which had a prominent spot in the Presbytery, then in his office at Tenterfield. It is now in the Parish Hall

With gratitude, parishioners returned him to God and to Mary, Help of Christians, for all eternity. Father Le Fevre was buried at Lincoln Grove Cemetery on Gunnedah Road. He was 69. May his dear soul rest in peace.

Rutete, Tanzania – a Land of Mission

The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette came to Rutete upon the invitation of the Bishop of Bukoba Catholic Diocese in Tanzania to start the La Salette presence in the country. The decision to open the mission in Tanzania was a response to the call of the Blessed Mother to "make her message known to all her people". The mission in Tanzania is the fourth country on the African continent where the Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette are present.

The diocese has entrusted to the Congregation the administration of a Parish-elect station (Parokia-teule in Kiswahili) located in the Village of Rutete in Rural Bukoba Tanzania, around 50 kilometers from Bukoba town, within the Kagera Region. The station is one of the highly-Catholic populated places in the diocese.

The Parish has two sub-stations within its jurisdiction. It has 15 villages on which 43 small Christian Communities (Jumuiya Ndogo Ndogo ya Kikristu – JNNK) were established. These small Christian Communities are playing a big role in the faith of the people in the parish.

Proceeds from the sale of the baubles is to support the livelihood project of Rutete Parish. The livelihood project targets to purchase 25 goats to be distributed to 25 families. Each family is tasked to raise the goat and give 1 female kid back to the parish so it can be given to another family. Each goat costs approx. A\$30
