Our History, Our Story | 1961-2021 1991-2000

Father Willis' first appointment was to Gunnedah for six years. He was transferred to Tamworth. During this time he was Chaplain at Tamworth Base Hospital, where he was highly respected for his dedication to patients and their families. Following Tamworth he was moved to Armidale and spent the next nine years at the Cathedral. He was appointed Parish Priest of South Tamworth in 1993, following the transfer of Father Frank Le Fevre to Tenterfield. He proved himself to be inspiring in his care of those in sorrow or troubles, his homilies were clear and concise; perhaps his greatest strength was in his care for the bereaved and those in need.

His sound business skills were used to great advantage in consolidating Parish assets and taking care of the debt. (Churches are not cheap.) Several new classrooms have been added at both school campuses, making St Edwards School the largest in the Diocese, the envy of other schools.
