The most recent ordinary jubilee took place in the year 2000, as the world and the Catholic Church prepared to enter the new millennium. Pope Francis chose "Pilgrims of Hope" as the motto for the Holy Year 2025. The Jubilee Year is a special year of grace, in which the Church offers the faithful the possibility of obtaining a plenary indulgence. Traditionally, it begins just before Christmas and ends on the Epiphany of the following year.
