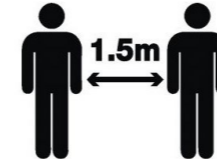

Pastoral Care for Seasonal Workers | Online Meeting

The Australian Catholic Migrant and Refugee Office (ACMRO) is currently collaborating with the Australian Catholic Religious Against Trafficking in Humans (ACRATH) in supporting a network of parishes and ministries doing pastoral care with seasonal workers under the Government's Pacific Australia Labour Mobility (PALM) scheme (*The scheme allows eligible Australian businesses to hire workers from nine Pacific Islands and Timor-Leste when there are not enough local workers available*). The purpose of the network is to work closely with the parishes and stakeholders who provide pastoral care for seasonal workers and assist with information sharing, capability building, and networking to better understand and facilitate the concerns and welfare of seasonal workers. The network's quarterly meetings and formation are just some of the activities to ensure the voices of the seasonal workers will be heard so that something concrete can be done. In line with this, we are pleased to invite you to our Parish & Stakeholders Providing Pastoral Care for Seasonal Workers Online Meeting/ Updating happening on Wednesday, 07 December 2022 at 2:00pm ADST via Zoom.
