Easter Blessing of Homes

Easter Holy Water for the blessing of homes are available for collection at the baptismal front for free. Please bring your own bottle/container. You may use the blessing prayer below. As the rooms are sprinkled, the head of the family may read the following prayer: Make the sign of the cross (+).

Graciously hear us, Holy Lord, Almighty Father and Eternal God, that, even as You protected the homes of the Hebrew people leaving Egypt by means of the destroying angel; which homes were stained with the blood of a lamb which prefigured our Pasch in which Christ was immolated; so may you in the same manner condescend to send your holy angel from heaven that he may guard, foster, protect, visit, and defend all the inhabitants of this dwelling. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen. *Pray 1 Our Father... 1 Hail Mary... 1 Glory be...*

The remainder of the blessed water may then be placed on the home altar.


