#### **Act of Spiritual Communion**

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. #### THE HISTORICAL FIRSTS IN THE VATICAN

- 1. Peter, the first Pope, came from present-day Golan Heights in war-torn Syria. Where did the other 265 Popes come from? 196 from Italy, 15 from France, 11 from Greece, etc. in the 2,000-year old papacy.
- 2. Pope Francis is a Pope of firsts: first Jesuit, first Francis, and first Pope from Latin America. He's also the first pope in 600 years to take office after Pope Benedict XVI, the 264th successor to St. Peter, shocked the Catholic world when he resigned in February 2013. Popes are supposed to run out the clock and just wait for time to come knocking and die in office.
- 3. Benedict XVI will be remembered as the first pope to join the Twitter community and the first pope to speak to astronauts in outer space.
- 4. The word Vatican is derived from the Latin, *vates*, which means "TELLERS OF THE FUTURE." More than 10 million tourists visit St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican City a year.
- 5. The Vatican installed its first central telephone system in 1866 (invented by Gian Battisti Marzi) five years before the United States. It's been estimated the Vatican receives about 25,000 calls a day and as many as 40,000 a day during the Christmas season.
- 6. Pope Francis has created 121 cardinals from 66 countries, 23 of which had never been represented in the College of Cardinals: the first Scandinavian since the Reformation, the first from Goa since an episcopal see was established there in 1533, the first from Latin America's indigenous peoples, and the first from India's Dalit class; the first cardinals from their countries (Cape Verde, Myanmar, Panama, Tonga, Brunei, Singapore).
- 7. For the first time ever, Pope Francis appoints three women officials to the Vatican office that selects bishops: the Dicastery for Bishops.
- 8. Pope Francis also named religious sister Nathalie Becquart an Undersecretary of the Synod of Bishops, making her the first woman to have the right to vote in the Catholic Synod of Bishops.


