the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.



November is a special time of the year devoted by the Holy Mother Church to ou beloved departed. During this month, the Church asks us to redouble our prayers and sacrifices for the remission of debt incurred by the faithful departed whose sins have already been pardoned. We are pleased to accept names of the deceased to remembered at our altar during Holy Mass. You can enrol the names of your beloved deceased using the envelope found at the foyer. Remembrance list will be updated each week. All mass offerings will be offered in general and in particular through the whole months of November and December.

All Souls' Octave (November 1-8)

Every year on these eight days the Church grants a plenary indulgence that can be applied only to the souls in purgatory. The faithful can receive this indulgence each of the eight days to apply to a particular soul a parent, spouse, relative, friend, or anyone even unknown. On each day from Nov. 1-8 a person seeking the plenary indulgence for a soul must 1) devoutly visiting a cemetery and at least mentally praying for the dead; (2) on All Souls' Day devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father, Hail Mary, Creed devoutly reciting prayer, "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen."

Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

1. Do the work while in a state of grace, 2. Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work, 3. Receive Eucharistic communion (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception), 4. Pray for the pope's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary, or other appropriate prayer, is sufficient), 5. Have no attachment to sin (even venial) i.e., it is sufficient that the Christian makes an act of the will to love God and despise sin.

Prayer for the Dead

God our Father, Your power brings us to birth, Your providence guides our lives, and by Your command we return to dust. Lord, those who die still live in Your presence, their lives changed but do not end. I pray in hope for my family, relatives and friends, and for all the dead known to You alone. In company with Christ, Who died and now lives, may they rejoice in Your kingdom, where all our tears are wiped away. Unite us together again in one family, to sing Your praise forever and ever. Amen.

A Prayer for the Forgotten Dead

O merciful God, take pity on those souls who have no particular friends and intercessors to recommend them to Thee, who, either through the negligence of those who are alive, or through length of time are forgotten by their friends and by all. Spare them, O Lord, and remember Thine own mercy, when others forget to appeal to it. Let not the souls which Thou hast created be parted from thee, their Creator.

May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
